A reminder to residents that the emergency paging system is to be used in cases where you require Ambulance or Fire services for emergency assistance. It is not the Town's responsibility to ensure that resident's walkways and/or driveways are cleared to allow for emergency access please ensure that you have made arrangements for your own personal snow clearing. To adequately clear the snow from the side lanes, it is important that vehicles not park on the side of the roads. The Town is asking that all dog owners keep their dogs from roaming. We are asking residents to please ensure that your civic address is located on your home. The Ambulance cannot take postdated cheques, payment by cash or personal cheque only.
